# *Windsor Fair Artwork*

## *Instructions*

Entry forms must accompany all entries. A copy of the entry form may be downloaded from fair website [ <http://www.windsorfair.com> ]. All entries must be the original work of the submitting artist.

### **Entries must be submitted by April 1st.**

The words Windsor Fair and the Dates of the fair will be added to the design of the poster; after design selection is made. No wording on the poster, unless specific to design. (the Fair has their own script and dates).

Poster size is 16" x 20", approximately 14" x 17" space for artwork. The artist could envision various sized t-shirts as well.

### Other considerations:

Crosshatching does not reproduce cleanly on t-shirts material.

Frames, borders and large geometric shapes become distorted on fabric.

Watercolors lose some of their integrity on fabric.

Nine colors is a good maximum number for this kind of work.

Too much white gets lost on fabric.

No small sketchy designs (needs to be bold and graphic).

It is wise to photocopy the black and white version, recording colors as added to insure a quality reproduction.

Must be original artwork.
