

WINDSOR FAIR ARTWORK INSTRUCTIONS

Entry forms must accompany all entries. A copy of the entry form may be downloaded from fair website (<http://www.windsorfair.com>). All entries must be the original work of the submitting artist.

Entries must be submitted by April 15th.

The words Windsor Fair and dates of the fair will be added to the design of the poster, after design selection is made. No wording on the poster, unless specific to design (the Fair has their own script and dates that are used on top and bottom of poster).

Poster size is 16" x 20", approximately 14" x 17" space for artwork. The artist should envision various sized t-shirts as well.

Other considerations:

Crosshatching does not reproduce cleanly on t-shirt material.

Frames, borders and large geometric shapes become distorted on fabric.

Watercolors lose some of their integrity on fabric. Keep bright.

Nine colors is a good maximum number for this kind of work.

Too much white gets lost on fabric.

No small sketchy design. Needs to be bold and graphic.

Must be original work, no digital artwork.

If you haven't attended a traditional agricultural fair for a while, remember...

Harness Racing, Midway with ferris wheel and merry-go-round, dairy and beef cattle, goats, sheep shearing, chickens, baby animals with mothers, pulling horses and oxen, tractor and truck pulling, vegetable garden produce, bees and honey, maple syrup and trees.
