### RULES AND REGULATIONS: (Please read, see changes)

1. All fowl exhibited, INCLUDING WATERFOWL, must be blood-tested and rated Pullorum Typhoid Clean, or be first generation from stock meeting this requirement. Exhibitors must show proof of testing IN ADVANCE. Any bird showing signs of disease or vermin shall be removed immediately. Pigeons do not need to be state tested.
2. Classes: Cock, Hen, Cockerel, Pullet.
3. Birds may be handled only by the exhibitor, judge, judge's steward, or fair official.
4. Bantams will be judged by latest ABA Standard and Large Fowl by APA Standard of Perfection.
5. PROTEST: Must be filed with the show secretary within 30 minutes of judging breed along with \$5.00 fee to be returned if upheld.
6. Birds will be released from the show Monday, Labor Day at 4:00 p.m. If inclement weather, please check for early release. Be prepared to collect your birds at 4:00 so cleaning can be started. If exhibitor is not present, birds may be moved to a neutral area.
7. Show sponsor will not be responsible for loss or damage to birds, although all possible care will be taken.
9. Birds must be cooped by 9:30 a.m., Sunday, first day of the fair, to be eligible for competition. (Coops will be set up Saturday for early cooping, from 2 pm till 8 pm) Judging will start at 10 a.m.

Entry Fee: \$1.00 per bird. Please include a copy of your Pullorum Typhoid test card with your entry form

## NO YOUTH POULTRY SHOWMANSHIP

### Notice to Poultry Exhibitors:

All birds entered at this show must be of a breed and variety that is recognized by the American Poultry Association or by the American Bantam Association. Birds must be entered with both a breed and a variety name. Please check with the APA or ABA Standards of Perfection for the correct names. Commercial crosses should not be entered in the exhibition classes. Birds must have the correct characteristics for their breed and variety in order to be considered by the judge for prize money. Check body shape, comb type, leg color, beards (vs. non-bearded), shanks (feathered vs. clean) before entering your bird. Birds showing a large number of dirty or broken feathers or showing external parasites should NOT be entered. Birds in this condition produce an inferior exhibit for the fair and fairgoers.
