Youth will be paid the same as adults unless indicated. **Please enter a 'Y' before the class letter on the youth entry forms**.

BEST OF SHOW: There will be an additional cash premium and a rosette for each outstanding exhibit in the Windsor Fair Exhibition Hall. Youth will also receive a cash premium and a rosette for outstanding exhibit. All exhibits are eligible for Best of Show Awards but may not be given in all classes.
